Below is a brief description of our significant events or activities.

Huddles

Huddles are our Wednesday night program during the school year. Huddles are small groups that split up and have an adult (their coach) lead a discussion. Huddles are generally split up by age and gender. Huddles allow dialogue and interaction between our students and a mentor (their coach) who cares about them. It also helps build community among students.

Ignite Family Worship Night

Once a month, we have a devotional at the home of one of our Kingwood members. These devotionals usually are on the third Sunday night of the month.

Service Projects

Retreats

KSM has a fall retreat and a spring retreat each year. The dates and locations vary each year. These retreats are usually Friday night through Sunday afternoon. Various adults always come along to help out on these trips. Our retreats are one of our favorite activities each year and allow our students time to get closer together and closer to God.

Winterfest

Winterfest is a youth rally in Gatlinburg, TN. It is in February each year. We leave early Friday morning (I provide a note for school if necessary) and return Sunday afternoon. We usually take a large group on this trip. We stay at a hotel in Gatlinburg and participate in all Winterfest sessions that include fun/entertainment, worship, and lessons.

IMPACT

IMPACT is a summer church camp at Lipscomb University in Nashville. We stay on campus in the dorms. There is a junior session for 6th through 8th graders and a senior session for 9th through 12th graders. IMPACT is in the middle of June.

Camp KAIO is Kingwood's summer day camp for kids ages 3-7th grade. Our 6th & 7th graders participate as senior campers, where they hang out together and do different activities in the afternoon. Our 8th-12th graders are counselors who help chaperone all the junior and mini campers.

Other Activities

Sometimes these activities last for one day, such as a trip to Nashville Shores, Lanes, Trains, and Automobiles, the movies, swimming, and more.
